

THE FINANCIAL STABILITY COUNCIL HELD ITS REGULAR MEETING

On 23rd of June 2014, Financial Stability Council (FSC) has held its regular session meeting. Through the meeting, the FSC discussed: (i) FRC proposal on opportunities to directly include NBFIs for inter-bank FX transactions and CBB transactions with the BoM, (ii) Mongolia's sovereign rating and the analysis of its driving factors, (iii) an update on Mongolia's external sector and the domestic foreign exchange market, and (iv) formats of the decisions made by Financial Stability Council.

In accordance with decisions of the meetings, members of the Council, within their respective functions, assigned duties and delivered recommendations to the relevant parties.
